Wayfarer 2009 North American Championship Regatta August 15th & 16th 2009

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: United States Wayfarer Association and Canandaigua Yacht Club

The race course will be shared with Vanguard 15's. There will be separate starts for each class.

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2009 to 2012 *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and REGISTRATION:

2.1 All boats of the Wayfarer fleet are invited to participate.

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached entry form and returning it by mail to Nick Seraphinoff. Entries may also be submitted via email to nseraphinoff@comcast.net

2.3 The entry fee is \$45.00 per boat for members of US Sailing or equivalent national association and \$50.00 for non-members. Please include a copy of current US Sailing membership card.

2.4 Registration packets will be available at the club house from 6pm on Friday the 14th August. Email registrants may pay regatta fees at this time.

2.5 All boats must be insured [Please supply proof of insurance with your registration form]

3. MEASUREMENT:

3.1 Boats entered in the races must comply with Wayfarer measurement requirements. Entrants should contact Class Measurer, in advance of the regatta, to clarify or confirm any questions concerning compliance.

4. SCHEDULE:

4.1 There will be a skippers meeting on Saturday August 15th at the water front at CYC at 8:30 am. Each boat is requested to send a representative to this meeting.

4.2 The Race Committee will run as many races as possible weather permitting on Saturday and 2 to 3 races on Sunday. Racing will start on Saturday at 10:00 am, and Sunday at 9:30 am.

4.3 No race will start after 12:00 noon on Sunday.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at CYC at registration, and on the web page (www.sailcyc.com) by Sunday August 9th.

6. RACING AREA and COURSES: The racing area will be on Canandaigua Lake. The courses shall be windward leeward or triangle-windward-leeward and will use temporary Club buoys. The target time for the first boat to finish is 30 minutes.

7. PERSONAL SAFETY: The following safety equipment must be on board, 30 foot painter, anchor, one paddle, two U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD's.

8. SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4 of the *RRS*, will apply. A minimum of three races must be sailed to constitute a regatta.

9. LAUNCHING: Boats may be rigged and stored on the blacktop at CYC for the duration of the regatta and ramp or hoist launched.

10. PRIZES: awards for both crewmembers shall be awarded to first through third place finishers. The rotating trophy for 1st place will be awarded.

11. SOCIAL:

The entry fee includes coffee and continental breakfast the morning of 2 race days provided by the USWA

For an additional charge lunch will be available at the club on Saturday for Wayfarer sailors, family members & friends.

Dinners, with special menus are planned at the club for all Wayfarer sailors, family members & friends, for Saturday evening - dinner reservations, meal choices and payment can be made at registration.

Camping is available on the club grounds with use of the club showers and toilets permissible.
