Saturday, 30 June (Trout Lake Picnic Sail)

9:30 am	Meet at Armstrong Beach – corner of Highway 63 (Trout Lake Road) and Lakeside Drive next to the MNR building	Area for parking and good launching ramp.
10:30 am assuming wind is “up”	Commence a exploration sail of Trout Lake with aim of getting to Camp Island at the east end of the lake for picnic lunch.	See map provided.
1:00 pm	Picnic at Kirkwood (Camp) Island	
2:30 pm	Start sail back up Trout Lake to Armstrong Beach.	Normally, a very pleasant sail on a south west breeze.
4:00 pm to 5:00 pm	Boats out, pack up, ready to move over to the North Bay Waterfront on Canada Day	Adhoc dinner arrangements.

Sunday, July 1 (Canada Day Race – an annual NBYC Event for all classes of sail boat)

10:30 am	Wayfarers to North Bay waterfront govt. dock arrive for setup and launch	Nominal Marina launch fee normally waived for event.
11:30 to noon	North Bay Yacht Club - Registration and skipper's meeting	At Rotary kiosk at waterfront. NBYC Registration fee for boat \$25
1:00 pm	Canada Day Race and Sail past start in front of govt. dock	Mass start all boats.
3:30 pm	Approximate time of arrival of fleet at NBYC	Arrangements to go back to NB waterfront for auto and trailers.
4:00 pm to 7:00 pm	NBYC barbeque after race (prizes, trophies)	Dinner hosted by NBYC. Very reasonable cost, normally about \$20 pp

Monday, July 2 (National Long Distance Race)

9:30 am	Registration available	At Club House
10:15 am	Skipper's Meeting	Review Race Instructions, starting instructions.
10:45 am	Wayfarer launch completed	Clear loading ramp a.s.a.p. Bring own snacks and drinks for this race. Expect 3 to 4 hours.
11:15 am (approx.)	Start – “National Long Distance Race”	Wind dependent timing
3:00 pm	Anticipated finish time for NLDR in front of NBYC pier.	Allow 60 minutes after lead boat finish for DNFs (may be extended by committee discretion)
