The Rock Hall Yacht Club will host the 2023 Summer One-Design Regatta as a two-day event on Saturday June 17<sup>th</sup> and Sunday June 18<sup>th</sup>, following Friday's Annual Down River Race. The One-Design Regatta is the cornerstone of the summer for the RHYC, so we are excited to continue the tradition, while providing a safe and fun regatta experience for our racers and volunteers!

The Rock Hall Yacht Club is located at the confluence of Lankford Creek and the Chester River, on the Chesapeake Bay's picturesque Eastern Shore. This stretch of the beautiful Chester River is a great place to sail One-Design boats since there is a lot of open water, limited powerboat traffic, easy beach and lift launching and plenty of grass on which to park and rig. The members of RHYC welcome you and appreciate your attendance at our regatta. Be safe and have fun.

- 1.) **Racing Rules:** This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, and the respective class association rules, except as any of these rules are changed by the SIs or any appendices to the SI. This regatta is designated **Category A** in accordance with RRS Appendix J1.2(2), ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.) **Eligibility:** There will be starts for each one-design class if 5 or more boats are registered (including):
  - Windmill
  - Wayfarer
  - Comet
  - A Cat
  - Hobie
  - Hampton One Design
  - Laser/Radial
  - DaySailer
  - Albacore
  - Chesapeake 20
  - Rebel
  - Open Monohull Class for the C. Doune Greene Memorial Trophy
  - If there are fewer than five boats in a class, the RC may combine starts with similar speed and size classes.
  - No-show classes will be eliminated from the starting lineup.

- 3.) **Schedule of Events:** Several races may be sailed on each day at the discretion of the RC.

The RHYC Log Canoe Lounge will be open for food and beverages all day on Saturday and until 6pm on Sunday for competitors and their families. **Social distancing and masking must be practiced if required by State of Maryland and/or club policy during the regatta dates.**

- 4.) **Registration and Fees:** Eligible participants **MUST** pre-register for the Regatta at the RHYC website at [www.rockhallyachtclub.org](http://www.rockhallyachtclub.org) by following the link to “Regattas” and online registration, or at <https://rockhallyachtclub.org/register/regatta/yA7iZLI84p/class>. This online registration service is provided by TheClubspot. No on-line registrations will be accepted after 2200 on June 16<sup>th</sup>.

**All registrants must check-in at the Pavilion/Clubhouse on Saturday morning.**

The fees for this Regatta are:

Junior	\$50 Double / \$25 Single

Fees include continental breakfast each morning for each competitor, awards as earned, and use of the RHYC grounds, bath house and Pavilion for the weekend. This is a bring your own water bottle event.

**Saturday Dinner:** \$30.00 per person (**includes tax and gratuity**), \$16.00 for kids 12 and under (**includes tax and gratuity**). **Buffet Menu:** 1/4 BBQ Chicken, Pulled Pork, Gumbo, Mac & Cheese, Red Beans & Rice, Corn on the Cob, Biscuits, Corn Bread, Garden Salad, Banana Pudding, Peach Cobbler. **Vegetarian/Vegan meal is available on request.**

**Lunches:** \$10.00 per person per day (**includes tax**).

**Camping:** There is plenty of land to camp and the RHYC bathhouses are open 24 hours. Tent camping is \$17/night, and an additional \$12/night for campers/RVs requiring electrical hookup (110 service only).

**Dinner, Lunch and Camping must be ordered in advance on the Clubspot site. You will find the ticket selections on the screen just prior to final checkout/payment.**

- 5.) **Sailing Instructions:** The SI will be online at [www.rockhallyachtclub.org](http://www.rockhallyachtclub.org). **Notices and Changes** to the SIs will be announced at the online Skippers Meeting and posted at the Beach.
- 6.) **Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A2 of the RRS will apply except as modified by the following: a minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
  - A. **Windmill Class:** if five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her (1) one worst race score. (WCA By-Law XIII. 14.G.1)
  - B. **Wayfarer Class:** if five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her (1) one worst race score.
- 7.) **Awards:** Trophies will be awarded for all classes, as well as for the Down River Race, on Sunday afternoon as soon as scoring is complete. Trophy places per class will be determined based on numbers registered for each class one week prior to the event. The organizing authority will review the registered competitors in each class and make a determination on the final trophy order. General guidelines are as follows: 3 boats, one place awarded. 5 boats, two places awarded. 7+ boats, three places awarded.
- 8.) **Facilities:** Launching facilities include ramp, hoist and beach launching; a nearby public ramp also allows water access for trailered boats. The RHYC grounds are free of all overhead wires. **A port-a-pot and handwashing station is available at the Beach, and the RHYC bathhouses are open 24 hours.**

- 11.) **Risk:** All competitors are ultimately responsible for the inherent risks associated with sailboat racing. It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. Each competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on- shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
